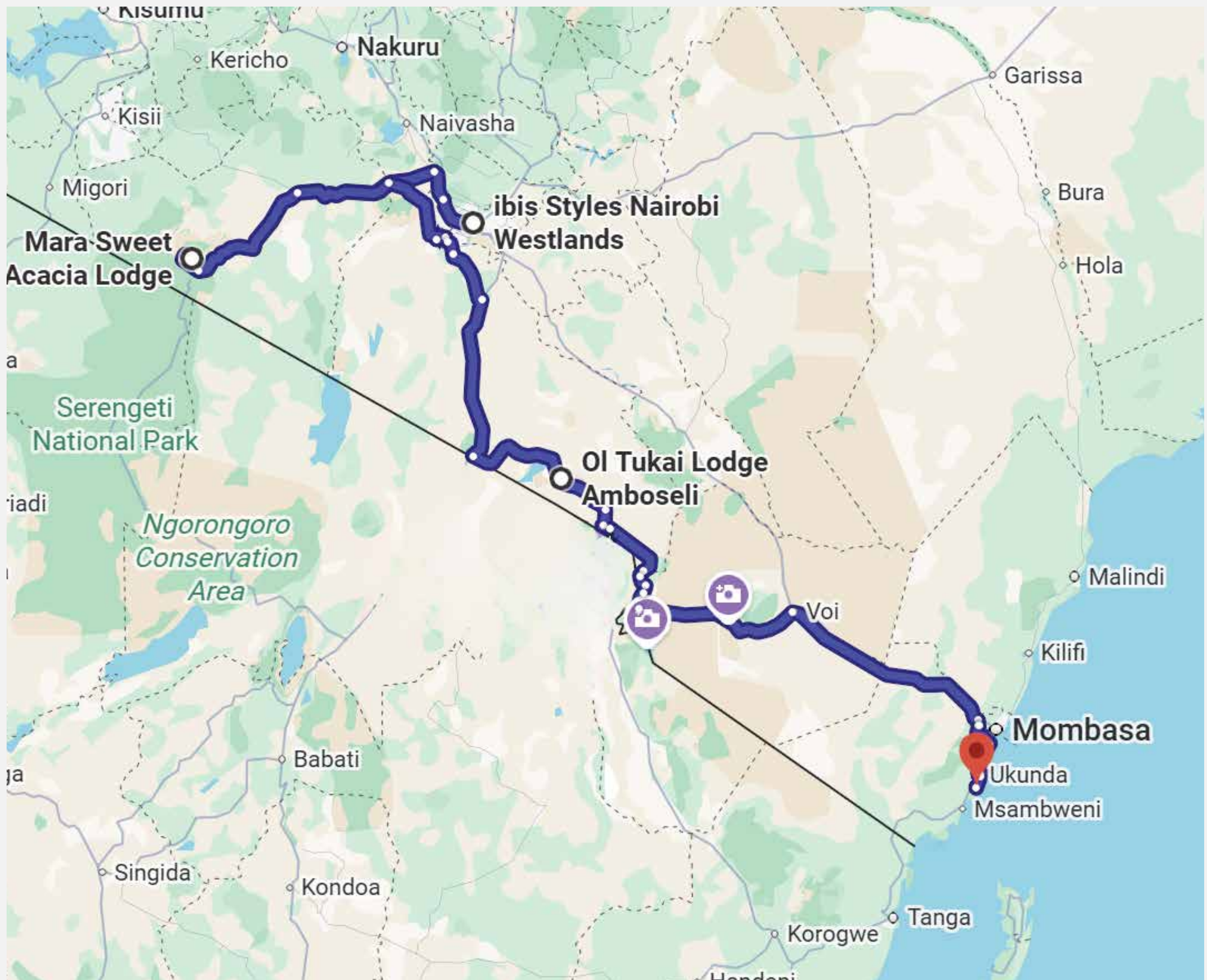




13 DAY KENYA SAFARI & BEACH HIGHLIGHTS



NAIROBI - MAASAI MARA - AMBOSELI - DIANI BEACH - NAIROBI

This journey blends Kenya's legendary wildlife with time on one of the Indian Ocean's most beautiful beaches. From the lively energy of Nairobi to the rolling savannahs of the Maasai Mara, the open plains beneath Mount Kilimanjaro in Amboseli, and then the palm-fringed shores of Diani Beach, this itinerary captures the rhythm, colour and warmth of Kenya.

NAIROBI

Nairobi is a city of vibrant energy and striking contrasts, where modern urban life blends seamlessly with rich cultural heritage and natural beauty. It offers a warm and engaging introduction to Kenya, inviting you to experience its creative spirit, welcoming people and diverse landscapes. Whether taking in the lively rhythm of the city or simply enjoying its green spaces and open horizons, Nairobi provides a memorable starting point for any journey into the country's wilderness and wildlife adventures.

Accommodation

ibis Styles Nairobi Westlands (1 Night)

Your first night is spent in the vibrant Westlands district at ibis Styles Nairobi Westlands, a contemporary city hotel that combines comfort with a relaxed urban atmosphere. The hotel is close to restaurants, cafes and nightlife and the interiors feel calm with soft lighting, clean lines and thoughtfully designed rooms. The decor is fresh and modern, with splashes of colour that reflect Nairobi's youthful energy. There is a restaurant serving international favourites with Kenyan touches, as well as a rooftop bar.

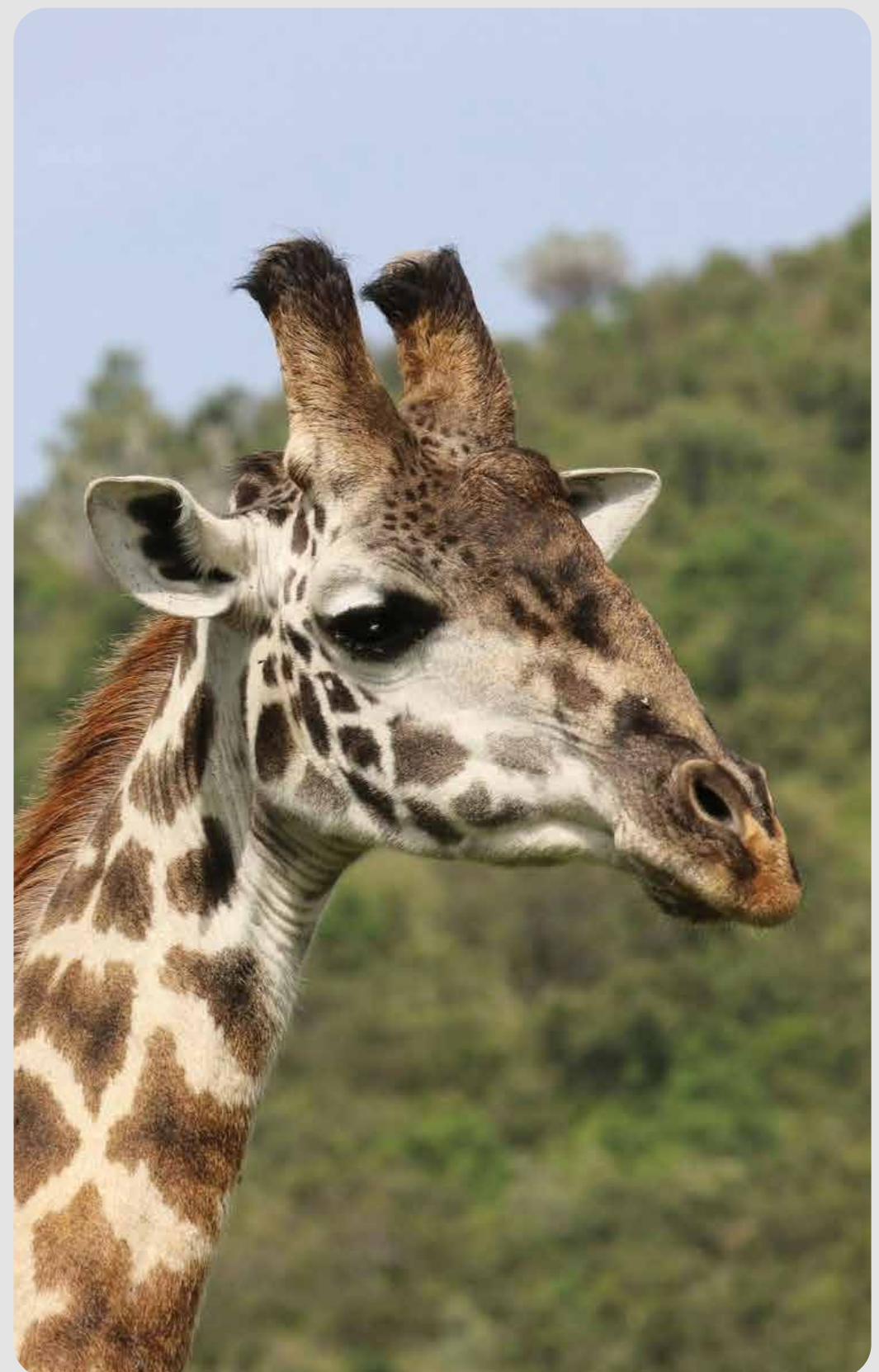
Transfers

Day 1 - Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by your guide and transferred to your city hotel for check-in.

Activities

Half Day Nairobi City Tour

- The tour begins at the Giraffe Centre, where you can meet endangered Rothschild giraffes and learn about local conservation efforts. You then continue to the Karen Blixen Museum, set in peaceful gardens and offering insight into the life and legacy of the Out of Africa author. Your final stop is Kazuri Beads, a women's cooperative where you can see handmade ceramic beads and pottery being created. It's a relaxed introduction to Nairobi's culture, history and community craft.



MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

The Maasai Mara is one of Africa's most iconic safari destinations. Endless golden plains stretch to the horizon, dotted with flat-topped acacia trees and crisscrossed by seasonal rivers. Wildlife is abundant year-round with big cats, vast herds of plains game and the famous Big Five all calling this landscape home. The Mara also shares an unfenced border with Tanzania's Serengeti, creating one of the greatest wildlife ecosystems on earth.



Accommodation

Mara Sweet Acacia Lodge (3 Nights)

Your lodge offers a comfortable and welcoming base in the Maasai Mara, set in natural surroundings with views over the savannah. Pathways link the main areas and guest rooms, creating a peaceful setting to unwind after your game drives. The main lodge features relaxed dining and lounge spaces, with outdoor seating overlooking the plains.

Transfers

Day 2 - After breakfast, your driver will collect you from ibis Styles Nairobi Westlands and transfer you to Wilson Airport for your scheduled flight to the Maasai Mara. Upon arrival at the Mara airstrip, you will be met and transferred to your lodge.

Activities

Game Drives in the Maasai Mara

- Your time in the Mara is spent exploring the reserve on guided game drives. You'll search for iconic wildlife including lions, elephants, cheetahs, buffalo and, with luck, leopards or rhinos. Your guide helps you interpret animal behaviour and spot smaller details you might otherwise miss. Every drive offers a new chance to witness the Mara's extraordinary wildlife moments.

Maasai Village Visit

- Visit a local Maasai village for a glimpse into traditional culture. You'll be welcomed by community members, shown around the manyatta and introduced to daily life and longstanding customs. It's a meaningful cultural experience that adds depth to your time in the Mara.



AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Amboseli is a classic East African landscape where wide-open plains are framed by the snow-capped peak of Mount Kilimanjaro just across the border in Tanzania. The park is famous for its large elephant herds that move across the dusty flats, often photographed with the mountain rising behind them. Swamps fed by underground water support hippos, birds and other wildlife, creating a rich mosaic of habitats in a relatively compact area.



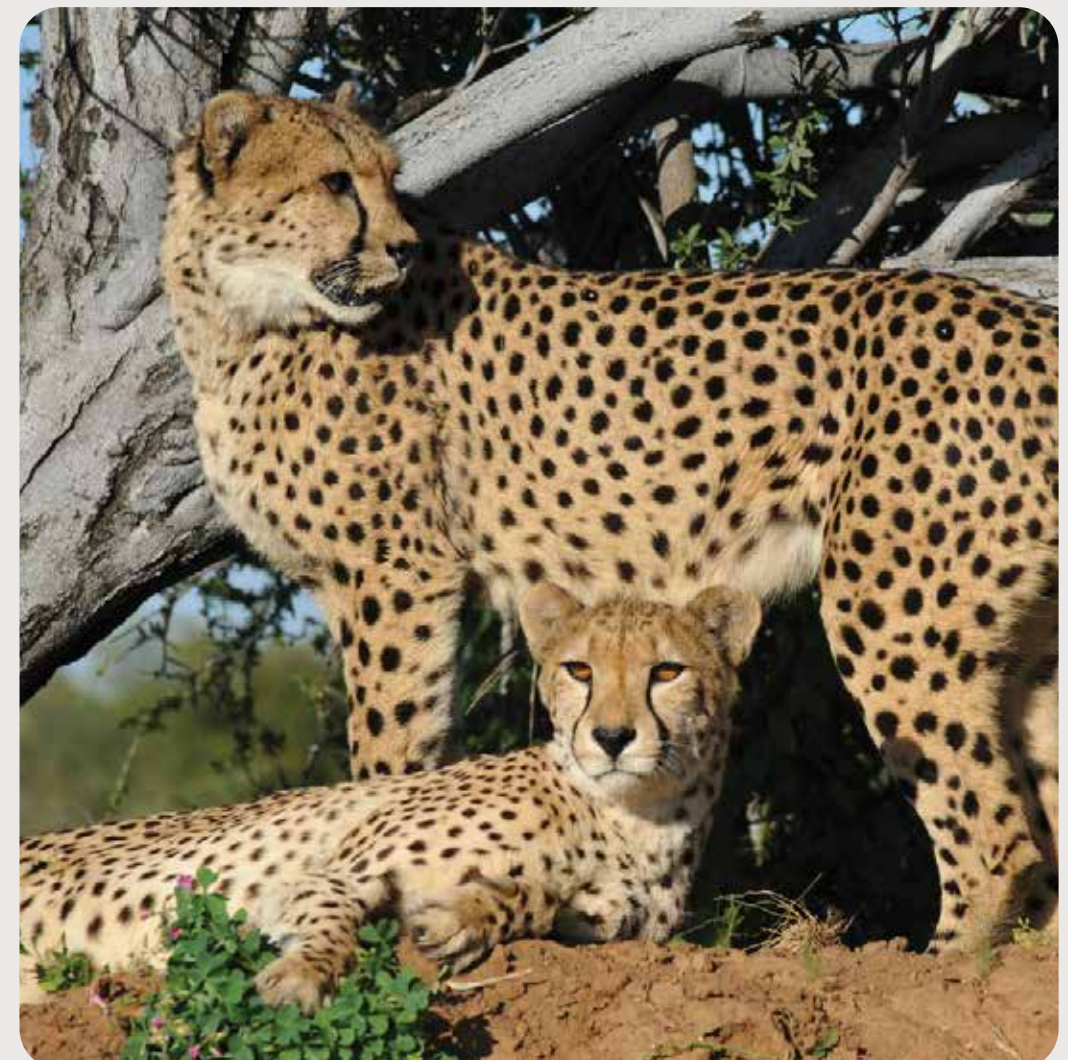
Accommodation

Ol Tukai Lodge (3 Nights)

Ol Tukai Lodge is beautifully positioned in Amboseli, offering open views toward Mount Kilimanjaro on clear days. The lodge sits in spacious grounds where elephants and other wildlife often pass through, creating a classic Amboseli feel. Rooms provide a peaceful retreat, each with a private terrace and en-suite bathroom. The main lodge includes a restaurant, bar, lounge and a swimming pool for relaxing between activities.

Transfers

Day 5 - After breakfast, check out of Mara Sweet Acacia Lodge and transfer to the airstrip for your flight to Wilson Airport in Nairobi. Upon arrival in Nairobi, you will board your connecting flight to Amboseli National Park. On landing at the Amboseli Airstrip, you will be met and transferred to your lodge.



Activities

Game Drives beneath Kilimanjaro

- Game drives explore Amboseli's open plains, wetlands and woodlands, with excellent chances to see elephants, big cats, giraffes, zebras and other wildlife. Kilimanjaro's backdrop and the park's sweeping views make each outing memorable, with plenty of opportunities for iconic photos. Guides help spot animals and interpret behaviour, adding depth to your experience.

Birdwatching and Wetland Life

- The wetlands of Amboseli attract an impressive array of birdlife. Flamingos and pelicans may be seen when conditions are right, along with herons, egrets, storks and many smaller species. Time spent near the swamps also offers close views of hippos, grazing elephants and other animals drawn to the permanent water.

DIANI BEACH

After days filled with game drives and wildlife encounters, you fly to the Kenyan coast for a change of pace. Diani Beach lies along the warm Indian Ocean, a stretch of powdery white sand backed by palm trees and lapped by clear turquoise water. The atmosphere is laid back and tropical with gentle sea breezes and colourful dhows on the horizon and the sound of waves replacing the calls of the bush.



Accommodation

Neptune Village Beach Resort & Spa (5 Nights)

Accommodation is at a beachfront property set in lush tropical gardens, with steps leading directly to the sand. Rooms are bright and comfortable, featuring air conditioning, mosquito nets and private balconies or terraces that make the most of the sea breeze. The resort offers a large swimming pool, several bars and a main restaurant serving a variety of international and local dishes. A spa offering massages and beauty treatments provides the perfect chance to unwind after your safari.



Transfers

Day 8 - After breakfast, check out of Ol Tukai Lodge and transfer to the airstrip for your flight to Wilson Airport in Nairobi. Upon arrival, connect to your onward flight to Ukunda Airstrip in Diani. On landing, you will be met and transferred to your beach resort.

Day 13 - After breakfast, check out of Neptune Village Beach Resort & Spa and transfer to Ukunda Airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi, marking the end of your Kenyan safari and beach holiday.

Activities

Beach Time and Water Sports

- Diani offers long stretches of white sand and warm ocean water perfect for swimming, walking or simply relaxing under the palms. If you'd like to be more active, you can enjoy water sports such as canoeing and snorkelling, or join optional local excursions like boat trips or diving. The shallow reefs and clear water make it easy to spot colourful marine life.

Leisure, Wellness and Entertainment

- You can enjoy light activities such as yoga, beach volleyball and table tennis, or simply relax at the spa with a massage or beauty treatment.
